

INTRODUCTION: 15267 is a medium dark gray regolith breccia. It is blocky, subangular, and coherent. It appears to lack zap pits. There is a glass cover on one side, which contains vesicles. 15267 was collected (with 15259, 15265, 15266, 15268, 15269, and 15285 to 15289) from the crest of an inner bench on the northeast wall of the 12 m crater at Station 6, downslope 15m from the LRV. It was part of the same rock from which 15265 and 15266 came, broken by the Commander, but 15267 has not been identified on surface photographs. It has never been subdivided or allocated.




Figure 1. Sample 15267. S-71-44225
