<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: 67518 is a white, moderately friable breccia which is fine-grained and homogeneous (Fig. 1). It lacks obvious clasts but has ~1% dark specks, possibly ferromagnesian minerals. It is possibly a pure, cataclastic anorthosite. It is a rake sample collected near the White Breccia boulders, and its friable surface lacks zap pits.
