

INTRODUCTION: 67947 is a light gray, slabby, coherent fragment (Fig. 1) which may have glass veins. The bulk matrix has distinguishable gray and white (plagioclase?) and brownish gray (mafic?) minerals and may be a basaltic impact melt. A small amount of fine-grained white material is embedded in the melt. It was collected from the regolith at the east-west split of House and Outhouse Rocks (see 67915, Fig. 1). Its orientation is unknown and it lacks zap pits.
