

78558**Dark Matrix Soil Breccia****3.78 g, 2.2x1.5x1.4 cm****INTRODUCTION**

Sample 78558 is a very friable soil breccia that was collected as part of a large rake sample at Station 8 (Fig. 1).

PETROGRAPHY

Butler (1973) described 78558 as friable, dark grey, matrix-rich breccia with clasts generally of millimeter size composing less than 5%. Small crusts are generally white plagio-

clase, mare basalt, black aphanite, and orange glass.

This sample has not been studied. It appears to be similar to 78555 (Keil et al., 1974).
